



Dear Student, Parent/Guardian,

On Monday 23rd July, 12pm to 7pm, you will meet with a Course Counsellor and your parent/guardian to select your subjects for 2019. Parents will be required to book an interview time via Compass with their individual parent login details to select a time for the interview. It is compulsory for students in years 9 – 11 to attend an interview to discuss the pathway(s) most suited. This day is a normal school day; however, you will be permitted to leave your class to attend the interview with your parent/guardian if the time booked is between noon and 3pm. During the last weeks of term 2 and the first week of term 3 students will, or have, been given explanations of the different expectations and structures of each year level
