



Dear Student, Parent/Guardian,

On Monday 24th and Tuesday 25th July, 12pm to 7pm, you will meet with a Course Counsellor and your parent/guardian to select your subjects for 2018. Parents will be required to book an interview time via Compass with their individual parent login details to select a time for the interview. It is compulsory for students in years 8 – 11 to attend an interview to discuss the pathway(s) most suited. These days are normal school days; however, you will be permitted to leave your class to attend the interview with your parent/guardian if the time booked is between noon and 3pm. During the last weeks of term 2 and the first week of term 3 students will, or have, been given explanations of the different expectations and structures of each year level

Please note that the process has changed from 2017, attendance is now required in order to process subject selections for 2018
